

## Freightliner Century/Columbia Mid-Roof/Condo Replacement Visor & 17" Drop Visor, 2003 & Earlier

### Part numbers 255XX

Before beginning the installation of your new Road *Works*® visor please verify that your truck is a mid-roof or a condo sleeper. If your truck is a flat top, then you do not have the correct visor. Call Road *Works*® Manufacturing, Inc. at 1-800-448-8741 for assistance in determining the correct part number. Please have the model, year, and style of sleeper of your truck ready when calling.

#### PLEASE READ THE DIRECTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE BEGINNING.

#### Installation

- 1. Remove factory visor skins and brackets. Set aside the hardware you removed that held the center bracket to the truck.
- 2. Arrange the brackets on a flat surface as shown in Diagram #2 on the reverse side.
- 3. Install the -01 center bracket using the factory hardware you set aside in step #1 (see Diagram #2 on the reverse side). Fully tighten these bolts.
- 4. Hold the -17 driver's side bracket and the -18 passenger's side bracket into the indentations on the cab and mark the holes. Drill the marked spots to ½" diameter, being careful not to damage the cab.
- 5. Install the -17 driver's side bracket and the -18 passenger's side bracket using 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" hex bolts, lock washers, flat washers, and neoprene well nuts in the locations marked and drilled in step #4. Fully tighten these bolts.
- 6. Loosely install a -14 bracket to the -17 bracket on the driver's side of the cab and the -16 bracket to the -18 bracket on the passenger's side of the cab using <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers, and hex nuts (see Diagram #2 on reverse side). Do not fully tighten these bolts.
- 7. Loosely install the remaining -14 bracket to the driver's side of the -01 center bracket and the remaining -16 bracket to the passenger's side of the -01 center bracket using <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers, and hex nuts (see Diagram #2 on reverse side). Do not fully tighten these bolts.
- 8. Peel the PVC film from the center joint only of the -13 and -15 visor skins.
- 9. Loosely install the -13 and -15 visor skins to the two -14 and the two -16 brackets which are on the cab using <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers, and hex nuts. Fully tighten the center joint together using <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" hex bolts, flat washers, lock washers, and hex nuts.
- 10. Loosely attach the outsides of the visor skins to the sides of the cab using 1½" carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers, and hex nuts. Important: Do not fully tighten these bolts!
- 11. Fully tighten the <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" carriage bolts securing the visor skins to the two -14 and the two -16 brackets from step #9.
- 12. Fully tighten the bolts that join the brackets together from steps #6 and #7.
- 13. Fully tighten the bolts on the sides of the visor from step #10.
- 14. Peel the PVC film from the visor skins. This completes the installation.

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
